



ZOONOSES OF HORSES

Zoonoses are diseases spread from animals to humans.

- Anthrax
- Brucellosis (*Brucella abortus*)
- Campylobacteriosis
- Colibacillosis (*Escherichia coli*)
- Dermatophilosis (rain rot)
- Dermatophytosis (ringworm)
- Eastern, Western, and Venezuelan equine encephalitis
- Influenza A
- Leptospirosis
- Methicillin-resistant *Staphylococcus aureus* (MRSA)
- Rabies
- *Rhodococcus equi*
- Salmonellosis
- Sporotrichosis
- *Staphylococcus*
- Streptococcosis (*S. equi*, *S. zooepidemicus*)
- Vesicular stomatitis
- West Nile fever
